



Servers

 - All patron-related API use including SIP is 100% encrypted
- There is NO single point of failure. Servers reside in top-tier Internet datacenters with Geographic Redundancy: your data is always valid on more than one server, in more than one city, with more than one hosting service.
 - Redundant connections to multiple Internet backbones
 - Staff, equipment, and software to protect against hackers
 - 24/7 Technical support with on-site spare hardware
 - Redundant, solid state disk drives
 - Backups every 1/2 hour to even different cities







- 2) URL for Kids' Catalog: In the Apollo Main Console, you'll see a new link to the Kids' Catalog. To obtain the URL for using in your search terminals or in emails, etc., you can click this new link and copy the URL from the address bar or you can right-click and then choose "Copy Link Location." (It will be of the form <libraryname>.biblionix.com/?kids=1)

- 3) Toggling/linking between the two catalogs: With two catalogs available, you may wish to manage navigation between them. For example, you may decide to have a PC in the library dedicated to the Kids' Catalog with no link to the general catalog. There is an option for that as well as the alternate case: to show or not show a Kids' Catalog link in the general catalog. In addition, there are related options to display or not display such links depending upon whether or not the patron is inside the library building (see below for what "inside the library" means).



These choices can be made in Setup | Advanced System Options. The conditions shown below are the defaults. These defaults will show a link from the general catalog to the Kids' Catalog both inside and outside of the library and no link from the Kids' Catalog back to the general catalog.
